NOTICE OF RACE

Sail Peninsula **23/24/25 FEBRUARY 2018**

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions of Australian Sailing and the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Category 5 keelboats both Spinnaker and Non Spinnaker classes, trailables and sportsboat divisions. The AMS, EHS and IRC handicaps will be catered for.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form no later than C.O.B. on Wednesday 21st of February 2018 Online entry is available at www.sailpeninsula.com.au

4 Fees

- 4.1 The Early Bird entry fee is \$175 per boat (before the 31st of December 2017 and the entry goes into a door prize) then \$250 after this date. This includes free berthing for Friday and Saturday nights.

5 Schedule

- 5.2 No Warning Signal shall be made after 13:00 hrs on Sunday 25th February 2018.

6 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available prior to Friday 23rd February 2018 on the SBSC website (www.sbsc.net.au) and the Sail Peninsula website (www.sailpeninsula.com.au).

7 The Courses

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:
For the Friday twilight race an SBSC fixed tower course of an appropriate length will be set depending on the conditions.

For the Saturday passage race Course 1 will be approximately 24nm and Course 2 will be approximately 16nm.

The course for the Sunday challenge/ team race will be approximately 14nm.

8 Berthing

Berthing will be available as part of the entry fee in the Martha Cove Marina for the Friday and Saturday nights. Boats arriving earlier or staying later please contact Martha Cove Marina phone: 03 5987 0827

9 Radio Communications

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. All competing boats shall have a working VHF radio with channels 16, 69, 71, 72, 73 and 77.

10 Prizes

There will be great sponsor's prizes for placing boats.

Presentation for the twilight race will be after racing on the Friday night, the passage race on the Saturday and the Bavaria Cup evening and Challenge/ Team/race in the Safety Beach Club House on the Sunday after racing.

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk and are responsible for the seaworthiness and sufficiency of a boat whose entry is accepted. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD 5 million, preferably AUD 10 million, per incident or the equivalent.

13 Rights to use name and likeness

In participating, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authorities, the Coordinating Authorities and the sponsors, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.
